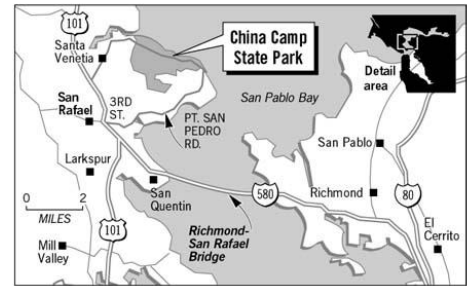


China Camp

Parking costs \$5 (pay by check or cash deposited in a little envelope into a box near entrance to parking lot.) This is a 1,600 acre State Park that's on the list to be closed, come see it while you still can! A Chinese shrimp-fishing village thrived on this site in the 1880s. Nearly 500 people, originally from Canton, China, lived in the village. In its heyday, there were three general stores, a marine supply store and a barber shop.
